STUDENT AGREEMENT FOR AFTERSCHOOL

Wired for Success Program Rules

1. Be Respectful—Listen when others are speaking & work quietly when you and others are doing homework or other assignments. Say Yes, Sir or No, Sir and Yes, Ma'am or No, Ma'am.
2. Be polite. Say "Please" and "Thank you." Wait patiently until new activities are offered. Do not ask to play games or go outside.
3. Treat others the way you want to be treated.
4. Obey the first time you are told to do something. When you are told "No" by one adult, do not ask another adult. The first adult's answer is final.
5. Let an adult know if you are having problems with another student. Do not be a part of a fight or an argument.
6. Do not complain about the snack that is available. If you do not like what is served, you do not have to eat. An alternative snack will only be served if there is an allergy. **Children may not bring snacks to the Center.**
7. If you finish an activity early, READ a book ON YOUR LEVEL for at least 20 minutes, then WRITE about what you read in the notebook provided. Do quiet activities (hidden pictures, puzzles, worksheets, etc.) while you wait for others to finish their work.
8. Do your chore well and without complaining.
9. One-on-one tutoring is not available. When possible, however, special assistance will be provided.

Understand that if you break these rules, and especially if you do anything to hurt another person or damage the building or equipment, you may be removed from the program. Understand that you are responsible for your own actions, not those of others and do your best to follow these rules, even if others break them. If an adult does not see a problem, please will let them know respectfully.

PARENT'S AGREEMENT AND CONSENT FORM

1. I AM RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- a. Picking up my child in the case he/she is ill or dismissed from afterschool.
- b. Being at the center or having someone I have previously authorized there ON TIME to pick up my child.
- c. Medical cost and insurance-neither C.A.R.E./The John 3:16 Center nor its staff or volunteers shall be liable for the cost of any medical treatment.
- d. Coordinating your time and volunteering for the 2 hours per week required for my child's participation in the program.
- e. Informing staff of any changes to my contact or other important information.
- f. Ensuring that my child understands that this program is a privilege, not a right, and they must demonstrate respect to the staff, volunteers, and facility to participate.

2. STUDENT'S PERSONAL PROPERTY

Neither C.A.R.E./The John 3:16 Center nor its staff or volunteers shall be responsible for the loss of or damage to the personal property of the student. Students should not bring electronic devices or any expensive items.

3. DAMAGE

Parents/guardians will be responsible for and pay for any damage done by their child either alone or with others.

4. ATTENDENCE AND PICK UP

If a child misses more than 2 days for 2 consecutive weeks, a child from the waiting list for the program may be accepted in their place.

Children must be picked up by 6 PM by an adult who is listed on the child/children's application. You are responsible for making such arrangements for your child. If you are continually late, your child(ren) will be removed from the Wired for Success Afterschool Program.

5. YOU MUST COME INSIDE TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD(REN). CHILDREN **WILL NOT** BE RELEASED TO AN ADULT WAITING OUTSIDE FOR ANY REASON. Children must be picked up by an adult and may not walk home.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENT

The John 3:16 Center and its staff understand that the parents and guardians of children in our after school program want to provide the best possible models for their children. As a result of this understanding, parents are required to complete two hours of volunteer work during each week of the afterschool program. If you are more than 1 month (8 hours) behind, your child(ren) will be removed from the program. Volunteer hours may be completed during afterschool time or during the regular work day of the center, but they will need to be scheduled at least one day prior to insure we are prepared for you. We realize that many of our parents may have strict working hours during our normal operating hours. If this is the case please see the director or assistant director for an alternative.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY:

The John 3:16 Center will be closed if Warren OR Halifax County School Systems close due to bad weather. Please check school closing notices for both counties. When schools close early due to weather, please plan on picking up your child as soon as possible, for the safety of your child, our staff, and yourself. The Center will close as soon as possible on these days in order to best ensure the safety of all involved. Your child's after school activities are your responsibility.

Photograph Release: I/we, the undersigned, hereby authorize The John 3:16 Center to use photographs, which I/we have voluntarily allowed to be taken by representatives. I/we understand that such use may

include, but shall not be limited to, publications, slide shows, displays, or videos. I/we hereby waive any right to which I/we or my/our heirs may otherwise be entitled by law to assert against The John 3:16 Center on account of injury sustained by my/our reputation arising from causes of action including, but not limited to libel, slander, defamation of character and invasion of privacy as a result of such publications and hereby release The John 3:16 Center from any liability on account of such injury.

Registration: The C.A.R.E./John 3:16 Center will attempt to provide reasonable accommodations for program participants when the need for accommodations is requested well in advance. To ensure a medically safe and appropriately planned program, please list any special needs or precautions which may require program accommodations for participation (i.e. visual or hearing impairment, mental or physical disability, heart condition, history of seizures, allergies, communicable diseases, diabetes, hemophilia, asthma, attention deficit disorder, etc.)

Fully and forever release and discharge C.A.R.E./John 3:16 Center, its agents, officials, and employees, from any and all claims, demands, damages, rights or action, or causes of action, present or future, whether the same be known, an anticipated or unanticipated, resulting from or arising out of the above described activity.
